FSP ANNUAL COMPLIANCE AUDITS

Federal Law requires your facility and FSP must be audited annually for compliance. This allows for any changes that may need to be made due to changes of situation or operations over the previous year.

FACILITY SECURITY ASSESSMENTS

An analysis which examines and evaluates the infrastructure and operations of the facility, taking into account possible threats, vulnerabilities, consequences, and existing protective measures, procedures and operations.
